About the Role

Feis Dhoire Cholmcille is seeking an experienced Web Developer to deliver a comprehensive redevelopment of our website as part of a time-limited digital transformation project. The role will focus on improving accessibility, functionality, data capture, and digital engagement for schools, competitors, and the wider community, while also supporting the preservation and presentation of our cultural heritage.

This is a fixed-term, delivery-focused role with a clearly defined scope of work to be completed within the contract period.

Working remotely, the successful candidate will ensure that the project is delivered on time, within budget, and to a high standard.

Scope of Work and Key Responsibilities

The Web Developer will be responsible for the design, development, testing, and deployment of the following elements:

1. Website Design, Layout, and Accessibility

- Refresh and modernise the overall look, structure, and user experience of the existing website
- Ensure full compliance with WCAG 2.2 accessibility standards, including accessibility auditing and remediation
- Improve navigation and usability for different user groups (schools, competitors, administrators, general public)



2. Secure User Areas

- Develop secure, role-based access areas for:
 - Schools
 - Individual competitors
- Implement appropriate authentication, data protection, and permissions management
- Ensure compliance with GDPR and best practice security standards

3. Registration System Enhancement

- Update and improve the existing registration system
- Ensure that data collection fields align with Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) requirements
- Improve data validation, user experience, and administrative oversight

4. Reporting and Data Management

- Design and build new automated reporting functionality for prize-winner data
- Enable reports to support the allocation of annual special bursaries
- Replace the current manual reporting process with a reliable, reusable digital solution

5. Podcast and Media Hosting Platform

- Create a new section of the website to host podcast and media content
- Integrate third-party tools and services such as Podbean, Loomly, and Vimeo
- Ensure content is easy to upload, manage, and access across devices

6. Digital History and Archive Section

- Develop a dedicated History section to showcase digitised archive materials
- Support structured presentation of historical documents, images, and media
- Ensure content is presented in an accessible, engaging, and sustainable way
- Create a teaser on the public facing page but with a subscription fee to enter secured site to obtain further historical information

7. Testing, Documentation, and Handover

- Conduct functional, accessibility, and user acceptance testing
- Address bugs and issues identified during testing
- Provide clear technical documentation and handover materials for future maintenance

- Demonstrable professional experience as a Web Developer
- Strong understanding of accessible web development, including WCAG 2.2
- Experience developing secure, data-driven websites and user registration systems
- Proficiency with relevant web technologies (e.g. HTML, CSS, JavaScript, CMS platforms, APIs)
- Experience integrating third-party digital tools and platforms
- Ability to manage a defined workload and deliver against deadlines within a fixed-term contract
- Strong problem-solving skills and attention to detail

Desirable

- Experience working with charities, cultural, education, or heritage organisations
- Familiarity with EDI-focused data collection and reporting
- Experience presenting archival or historical content online
- Knowledge of GDPR and data protection best practice
- Experience producing clear technical documentation for non-technical users
